

AUSTRALIA Visa Application Info (ETA)

AMERIASA can obtain Electronic Travel Authorisations (ETA) for most Malaysia visitors to Australia. At the time of application, the applicants must be outside of Australia.

To apply for an Australian Electronic Travel Authority (ETA) visa the applicant must not be inside Australian borders at the time of application. Certain trips will still require a traditional visa. These include temporary work assignments and other activities outside of tourism or business meetings.

The ETA is currently available for:

- Tourists with multiple visits with a maximum stay of three months per visit.

In both cases the visa has 12 months' validity from date of the grant of the ETA or to the expiry date of your passport, whichever is the earlier.

You may enter Australia up until the last day of the validity of the ETA and may then stay in Australia for up to three months.

The ETAs available on this site are not for:

- stays longer than three (3) months,
- those intending to stay permanently in Australia.

If you require a visa for these purposes, please contact the nearest Australia Visa Center

AMERIASA handling fee:

RM 50 per passport (only applicable for those booking their vacation arrangement with us)

Requirement:

1. Passport copy with a minimum validity of 6 months prior to departure date, Flight Ticket, Hotel Accommodation.
2. Normal processing for an ETA is 2-3 business days. If you require same day processing, this option is available for an additional charge.
3. Once your ETA has been approved, an email will be sent to the address you have provided in your application. This confirmation will provide you with the ETA confirmation you will need upon airport check in and entry to Australia.

Note:

- The Embassy has the right to request for any further document or call for interview or change their requirement immediately.
