| D02 | D | ISTANBUL – BOLU (258KM - 2H 50M) Upon arrival, meet and greet by local tour guide and transfer to Bolu. Enjoy your dinner and transfer to hotel for rest. |
| D03 | B, L, D | BOLU – ANKARA (187KM 2H20M) – CAPPADOCIA Breakfast at hotel and transfer to Ankara. Ataturk Mausoleum - Anıtkabir is a complex located in the Çankaya district of Ankara, which includes the mausoleum of Mustafa Kemal Atatürk. There are four main parts to Anıtkabir: the Road of Lions, the Ceremonial Plaza, the Hall of Honor and the Peace Park that surrounds the monument. Photo stop at Salt Lake. |
| D04 | B, L, D | CAPPADOCIA After breakfast, proceed to Underground City - It is very likely that these underground cities were built to withstand attack and can protect large numbers of people and their animals during crises period. Photo stop at Uchisar Castle Village and Pigeon Valley - It name comes from the thousands of pigeon houses that have been carved into the soft tuff since ancient times. In Cappadocia, pigeons have long been a source of food and fertilizer. The advent of chemical fertilizers has reduced the use of pigeon dung. Stop at Uc Guzeller "Three Beauties", Avanos Pottery Village (Shopping Stop) and Goreme Valley (Photo Stop). Enjoy Turkish cultural Belly Dance Show with dinner tonight. |
| D05 | B, L, D | CAPPADOCIA – KONYA (272KM 3H25M) – PAMUKKALE (394KM 5H) After breakfast and transfer from Cappadocia to Pamukkale. Tepesidelikhan Ancient Caravanserai (Photo Stop) Mevlana Museum - The main gate which is Devisan Kapısı of the museum leads into a marble-paved courtyard. It is also Turkey's most visited museum that year. |

| D06 | B, L, D | <p>PAMUKKALE – KUSADASI (189KM 2H50M)</p> <p>After breakfast and start the tour to Hierapolis & Cotton Castle - known for its thermal springs, natural terraces fed by hot mineral water, the pools in front of the travertines in one hand , the charming ancient Roman colonnaded streets, stores, temples, thermal baths on the other hand have made a great impact for healers.</p> <p>Ephesus Ancient City - one of the largest and most important cities in the ancient Mediterranean world, also known as one of the oldest Greek settlements on the Aegean Sea, and later the provincial seat of Roman government in Asia.</p> <p>Isa Bey Mosque - It is one of the oldest and most impressive works of architectural art remaining from the Anatolian beyliks.</p> <p>Temple of Artemis - The Temple of Artemis at Ephesus was located on the western coast of Asia Minor. It is also known as the Temple of Diana, was a Greek temple dedicated to an ancient, local form of the goddess Artemis.</p> |
| D07 | B, L, D | <p>KUSADASI – CANAKKALE (444KM 5H30M)</p> <p>After breakfast, proceed to Aegean Sea (Drive Pass) - The Aegean Sea is an elongated embayment of the Mediterranean Sea between Europe and Asia. It is located between the Balkans and Anatolia, and covers an area of some 215,000 square kilometres.</p> <p>Pergamum in Bergama (Drive Pass) – It's an ancient Greek building in Pergamon, Anatolia, today located nearby the modern town of Bergama, in the İzmir Province of western Turkey. It was one of the most important libraries in the ancient world.</p> |
| D08 | B, L, D | <p>CANAKKALE – ISTANBUL (358KM 5H)</p> <p>After breakfast, transfer to Istanbul, enroute visit to Trojan Horse (Photo Stop) - It is one of the biggest attractions of Canakkale city. The "wooden horse" was made famous by the movie Troy. (Exclude Troy Museum)</p> <p>Topkapi Palace - It is a large museum in the east of the Fatih district of Istanbul in Turkey.</p> <p>Grand Bazaar - one of the largest and oldest covered markets in the world, with 61 covered streets and over 4,000 shops</p> <p>Bosphorus Cruise Tour - Cruise along the Bosphorus and admire the variety of architectures on the European and Asian coast.</p> |
| D09 | B, L | <p>ISTANBUL - DEPARTURE</p> <p>Breakfast and transfer for Istanbul city tour. First stop at Blue Mosque - It is also known as Sultan Ahmed Mosque is a historical mosque in Istanbul. The mosque is known as the Blue Mosque because of blue tiles surrounding the walls of interior design.</p> <p>Hippodrome Square - It is horse carriage and gladiator fights took place during the Byzantine Empire. It is decorated today with an Egyptian Column, Serpentine Column and Ibrahim Pasa Palace.</p> <p>St. Sophia (Hagia Sophia) - It is also known as Hagia Sophia after the Ottomans captured Constantinople during 1453. It is one of the finest and famous examples of BYZANTINE architecture in the world. Today it is neither a Church nor a Mosque, but a museum. Photo stop at Sogukcesme Street. Free at leisure until transfer to airport for flight departure.</p> |
